Free Speech on Israel (FSOI) is a network of Labour, Green and trade union activists in the UK, mainly Jewish. We have come together to counter the pro-Israel right wingers - inside the Labour Party and outside - who try to brand as antisemitic the campaign for justice for Palestinians. They and their allies in the media have used false accusations of antisemitism to destabilise and undermine Labour leader Jeremy Corbyn.

At the end of June 2016, an inquiry established by Corbyn and headed by human rights lawyer Shami Chakrabarti upheld the right to free expression of political views on human rights, including on Israel and Palestine, and recommended positive steps the Labour Party could take to ensure equality for all members.

FSOI is campaigning to ensure that these important goals are not frustrated by Corbyn's enemies.
